Before the introduction of CaptionConnect Caroline received all of her instructions via an Auslan interpreter. Caroline's mother Halina had been employed by the school as an interpreter to support Caroline's learning. Halina has been instrumental in Caroline's education, playing a major role in supporting, advocating and interpreting for her daughter. The introduction of CaptionConnect alleviated some of the pressure on Halina to keep up with all of the teachers and the content.
